SVWID UPDATE – Kent Johnson gave an update on Leavitt Reservoir. Currently grinding up aggregate. Continuing to strip wet land topsoil. Moved from west barrow area across the draw to the east barrow area. Pipe has been delivered to site. The new dam will be 1800' wide. SVWID goes out every Wednesday to meet with the construction manager. There will be more activity in March, will bring in more equipment and get started with the delivery pipeline being installed. WWDC funding passed the senate now has to go to the house for the last part of their funding. Ashely will work on getting another drone footage of progress. Fred completed his Public Officer Training; others are working on getting theirs completed.

**NWID UPDATE** – John Joyce gave an update on the Alkali Creek Reservoir project. They are currently working on easements, still in negotiation with some landowners. Nothing further on designs. Working on feasibility for pipeline of Anita Ditch. The cost of pipeline is substantial and WWDC is looking to add that to the funding. Looking at installing two 48" pipelines instead of one 72" pipeline. Also looking at applying for additional federal funding for the pipeline. Engineers are working on the applications for that funding. The monthly meeting was held in Hyattville, they had a larger turnout than normal. The attorney attended to give their update as well as the engineers. Negotiating with Game and Fish to help with funds for the reservoir. Justine completed her public officer training; others still need to get signed up and complete theirs.

OFFICE REPORT - Ashley will be attending Leave no trace behind ag days, as well as attending WCDEA employee training in March. Ashley attended the February school board meeting to discuss the community garden at the Greybull Buff Ranch. Ashley has been working with Ales to complete the reimbursement request for a 319 project. The SVWID election is in progress and mail ballots are due by March 19, 2024.
